Concordia University welcomes and encourages students apply to for admission for the fall and spring semesters.

Does Concordia accept the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum?

Yes! Transfer students who have completed the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum or an associate of arts degree from an accredited institution are considered to have met Concordia's general education requirements with the exception of two religion classes (8 credits.)

What are the admission requirements?

Minimum 2.00 GPA with two letters of recommendation (one from the dean of students at the college and one from a non-relative.) Official transcript must be submitted with the admission application. See www.csp.edu/admissions

What scholarships are available?

Transfer students are awarded one of three scholarships (renewable for two additional years) based on cumulative GPA at the time of admission. The Transfer Regents Scholarship is a \$6,000 scholarship that is awarded to those who demonstrate a 3.50 GPA. The Transfer President's Scholarship is a \$4,500 scholarship that is awarded to those who demonstrate a 3.25 GPA. The Transfer University Scholarship is a \$3,000 scholarship that is awarded to those who demonstrate a 3.00 GPA. A transfer student who receives one of these awards must also attend full-time in undergraduate day classes and have completed a minimum of 20 semester credits prior to entering Concordia University.

Will I need to submit high school transcripts or ACT scores?

Transfer students with 30 credits or more are not required to submit high school transcripts or ACT scores.

What are the top majors at Concordia University?
