

**Articulation Agreement  
Between Century College and Concordia University-St. Paul**

Sending Program: A.A. Degree- **Century College**

Receiving Program: Bachelor of Arts in Education (Physical Education and Health Education)

**Statement of Purpose:**

This agreement has been entered into by **Century College** and **Concordia University- St. Paul**. The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related degree program to another. The attached appendices shall describe the required program of study at **Century College** for admission eligibility to **Concordia University-St. Paul** in the Bachelor of Arts in Education (Physical Education and Health Education) and the course of study required at **Concordia University-St. Paul** to complete the degree. This agreement identifies all required and equivalent courses at each institution.

**Terms and Condition of Credit Transfer:**

The parties of this agreement hereby agree to the terms and conditions set forth in this document.

The evaluation and transfer of earned college credits shall be in full compliance with MnSCU and Concordia University-St. Paul policies and all other state and federal education policies pertaining to undergraduate credit transfer. Current students and graduates who have earned appropriate degrees, certificates or diplomas from **Century College** shall be eligible for credit evaluation under the terms of the agreement. Program specific requirements and/or required courses are listed in the appendices of this agreement.

Transfer students will be accorded the same standards and criteria for admission to a major program as students who originated their education at **Concordia University-St. Paul**.

Associate of Arts degree transfer students and others who have completed the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum are exempt from additional lower division general education courses unless the degree program requires specific lower division general courses.

Applicants accepted must fulfill the graduation requirements of the degree-granting institution.

**Collaborative Practices:**

Tuition and fees will be paid to the institution from which the student takes a course.

Upon student request, each institution will forward transcripts to each from students in the program.

Both institutions will inform potential students about this program.
