



Saint Paul College to Concordia University, St. Paul Bachelor of Arts in Public Health

Students who plan to complete a **BA in Public Health** on campus at Concordia University, St. Paul (CSP) can complete the Public Health AS degree or the Associate of Arts degree at Saint Paul College (SPC). Completion of the AA degree at will satisfy CSP's general education requirements with the exception of Theology.
