<sup>1</sup>CSP recommends selecting either COMM 1021, COMM 1031, or COMM 1051 as COMM 1041 is not eligible for general education credit at CSP. Students who select COMM 1041 will have additional requirements to complete at CSP.

<sup>2</sup>CSP recommends selecting PHIL 1031 as PHIL 1035 is not eligible for general education credit at CSP. Students who select PHIL 1035 will have additional requirements to complete at CSP.

#### Transfer Policies:

- The above transfer guide is intended for fully completed MnTC Goal Areas only. Partially completed goal areas will be subject to course-by-course evaluation and does not guarantee transfer to a specific CSP general education area.
- An overall GPA of 2.0 or higher and major GPA of 2.0 or higher is required. (Unless the course applies toward the major, all transfer credit is accepted with a grade of Pass 'P' and does not impact your CSP GPA.).
- A minimum of 120 credits is required to earn a bachelor's degree from CSP. A minimum of 30 credits must be successfully completed at CSP and a maximum of 90 credits will be accepted in transfer.
- A minimum of half of the major credit requirements must be successfully completed at CSP.
- Completion of the full MN Transfer Curriculum will fulfill all general education credits at CSP, with the exception of Theology.
- Students may have additional credits earned from attendance at other schools, please be sure to submit all transcripts.
- The courses listed above are current as of the corresponding Academic Calendar. Course requirements are subject to change.
