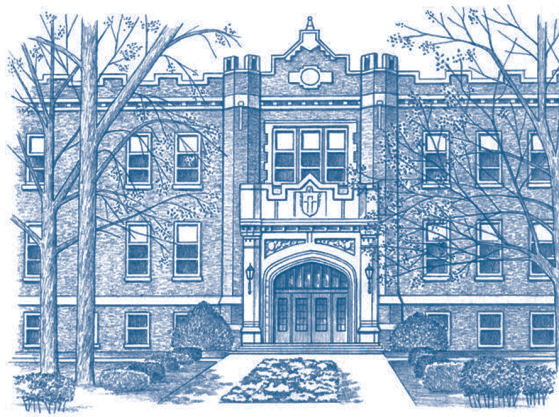

The Concordia University Seal



The Concordia University seal was originally designed by Dr. Theodore Buenger for Concordia College in 1895. The Lamp of Learning symbolizes the light of the knowledge of God’s Word illuminating the minds of the students as well as the darkness of the world. The Crossed Quills symbolize the writings of the student and the writings of the great individuals throughout history from which the student learns. The Moccasin Flower symbolizes the State of Minnesota and the beauty of God’s creation. The Latin inscription means, “I wish to be proficient in academics, but even beyond that, I wish to know Jesus.” It is based on Ephesians 3:19: “And to know the love of Christ surpasses knowledge.”

The Concordia University Mace

The Concordia University mace was designed by James and Dr. Sally Baas to mark the importance of formal events. This traditionally designed mace, a symbol of university scholarship and integrity, is used to lead the academic procession at commencement and other special ceremonial occasions. The mace was crafted by James Baas from red and white oak that signifies the strength and permanence of education and Christian faith. It is 47 inches in length and features the Concordia medallion on each of the four sides. The head is topped with a square ball representing the world and Concordia’s mission.

Notes on Academic Attire

The regalia and insignia that are worn in today's processional derive from centuries of academic tradition. Not only does it provide color and dignity to this festive occasion, but also identifies the wearers field of specialty and reflects their level of achievement.

The gowns are usually black, although in some instances, the institution from which the wearer graduated prescribes a different color. A pointed sleeve indicates the wearer holds a bachelor's degree, while a closed sleeve marks one who earned a master's

or educational specialist degree. Those who hold a doctoral or Ph.D degree have open, round sleeves and are further recognized by the velvet trimmings on the gown front and crossbars on the sleeves.

Similarly, the length and shape of the hood indicates whether the wearer holds an educational specialist, master's or doctoral degree. The color of the velvet trim on the hood identifies the field in which the degree was granted:

Those who have earned a bachelor's or master's degree wear black mortarboard caps, while the holder of an education specialist, doctoral or Ph.D degree wears a soft, six-sided tam. Some academic institutions, however, prescribe their own colors for caps, tams and tassels.

You may note, some professors wear a bronze medallion bearing the seal of Concordia University. This indicates that the professor has attained tenure at this institution.

ACADEMIC HONORS

Undergraduate students who have earned **60 or more credits at Concordia University, St. Paul** and have earned the following Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA):

- 3.90 or higher are designated as *graduating summa cum laude* (gold medallion)
- 3.75 to 3.89 are designated as *graduating magna cum laude* (silver medallion)
- 3.60 to 3.74 are designated as *graduating cum laude* (bronze medallion)

Undergraduate students who have earned **59 or fewer credits at Concordia University, St. Paul** and have earned the following Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA):

- 3.90 or higher will be recognized as graduating with high distinction (medallion with gold and navy ribbon)
- 3.75 to 3.89 will be recognized as graduating with distinction (medallion with white and navy ribbon)

Academic departments grant **Departmental Honors** in their majors to students who have completed selected course work including a capstone experience that demonstrates excellence in their field.

The **Ignite Leadership Certificate Program** supports students in identifying, developing, and refining their leadership skills and abilities through programming in 10 different competency areas. Participating in Ignite encourages students to engage with other student leaders, to develop workforce-ready leadership skills, and to become a more socially-just leader.

Solus Christus Fellows is a mentoring program that fosters reflection on the connections between the Christian faith, academic learning, and life together. In a small group setting, students lead and participate in discussions of readings that deepen their faith, build community, and help them to live well in their various God-given callings in life.

Concordia exists, in part, due to the legacy of those that have attended this institution and believe it changed their lives and can do the same for their family members. The Legacy Student recognition is granted to those who have had at least one additional family member attend Concordia University.



Rev. Jim Laatsch, J.C. '61 grew up on a farm in the unincorporated community of Caroline, Wis., about 45 miles northwest of Green Bay. One of eight children, he described his family as “poor,” sharing that they had no telephone, refrigerator, bicycle, baseball glove, or TV when he was growing up.

Jim first attended Concordia Teachers College (now Concordia University Chicago) in River Forest, Ill. before transferring to Concordia St. Paul to complete his associate of arts degree. It was during that first year Jim decided that, at some point in his life, he would donate \$1,000,000 to the church in thankfulness for his Christian education.

Karen grew up in a middle-class family in Queens Village, New York, a dynamic and diverse urban community. She left the city to attend Carleton College in Northfield, Minn., but it was back in New York where she met Jim, who was a summer intern at her congregation. They were married on September 2, 1966, just before Jim started his fourth year at Concordia Seminary, St. Louis.

After graduating from seminary, Jim’s first two pastoral calls were to congregations in Wray and Johnstown, Colo. Early in their marriage, Jim and Karen dedicated themselves to tithing from their income and focusing on faithful stewardship, including living off one income

while saving and investing from the other. When the Seminex controversy boiled over, Jim resigned his call and moved to Wisconsin.

Not sure of what to do next, Jim ended up running for a seat in the Wisconsin Legislature. Surprisingly, he beat the incumbent by a narrow margin and served two terms as a representative.

He returned to the ministry after six years and served many congregations in southern Wisconsin as a vacancy pastor. Always eager to serve his community, Jim also served on his local village board and was elected village president in Arlington, Wis.

Karen’s first job after graduation was with the Army where she bought repair parts for diesel engines. She then became a full-time mother and homemaker for ten years. Karen began a career with American Family Insurance when they moved to Wisconsin in 1977 and was a property insurance adjuster and then a corporate trainer before her retirement in 1998.

Wisely stewarding the financial resources with which God has blessed them has allowed the Laatsches to bless Concordia St. Paul, other Concordias, their congregations, and other ministries and nonprofits. In 2023, Jim and Karen gave the largest single philanthropic gift in CSP’s history, a \$10 million gift to establish The Rev. James F. “Jim” (JC ‘61) and Karen R. Laatsch Endowment for the Department of Theology and Ministry. The endowment funds two faculty chairs, The Edwin F. and Esther L. Laatsch Endowed Chair in Old Testament Theology and The Robert L. and Ruth F. Eckerman Endowed Chair in New Testament Theology.

Jim and Karen have had the opportunity to travel extensively throughout the world, enjoying God’s creation and people, including five weeks on a dig in Israel with the Rev. Dr. Mark Schuler, Emeritus Professor of Theology at CSP. In addition, they have hiked the Grand Canyon three times, been to 44 of the 50 state high points, traveled extensively throughout Europe and Asia, and have season tickets to the Madison Symphony Orchestra. Since 2015, Jim has completed a full marathon and Karen has completed a half marathon in all 50 states.

Throughout their life together, Jim and Karen have enjoyed God’s rich blessings, including their family, which includes three children, their spouses, and six grandchildren.

Rev. Dr. Michael Middendorf and his wife, Lana (Kinunen), graduated from Concordia St. Paul in 1981. He then worked in Concordia's admissions office for three years and served as a part-time instructor of Greek in 1982-83.

After completing his M.Div. (1987) and Th.D. (1990) at Concordia Seminary, St. Louis, Mike was Called to Concordia Lutheran Church, Jamestown, ND and then to Concordia University Texas. Since 2001, he has been a Professor of Theology in Christ College at Concordia University Irvine where he regularly teaches undergraduates, graduate students, and seminarians in CUI's Cross-Cultural Ministry Center.

Dr. Middendorf's dissertation, *The "I" in the Storm*, was published by Concordia Publishing House (CPH, 2007). He also co-authored a New Testament textbook, *Called by the Gospel* (Wipf & Stock, 2007) with CSP's own Dr. Mark Schuler. Mike's two-volume Concordia Commentary on Romans was published in 2013 and 2016. He served on the Commission on Theology and Church Relations of the LCMS from 2004-2010 and as a pastoral assistant at Trinity Cristo Rey, a bilingual congregation in Santa Ana, from 2009-2019.

Mike has made numerous trips to the lands of the Bible, including three summers on CSP's archaeology team at Hippos, Israel. He has also led groups to Israel, Greece, and Turkey.

Rev. Nabil Subhi Nour is a naturalized U.S. citizen. Born on October 29, 1955, in Nazareth, Israel to the late Subhi and Khairiah (Saliba) Nour. He majored in criminology and sociology with minors in psychology and gerontology.

On May 28, 1977, through God's mercy and grace, he was joined in holy matrimony to Jean Marie Miedema of Hitchcock, S.D. Into this marriage three lovely sons were given to them: Tony (wife Brenda, grandsons Brody, Broxton, and granddaughters Ellery and Ivy); David (wife Jody, grandsons Myles, and Simon, granddaughters Lucy and Sunny); and Michael (wife Katie, grandsons Brecken, Rowen and Suttan).

After the Holy Spirit worked on his heart he was converted to Lutheranism and received encouragement to consider the pastoral office from his fellow church members and pastors, specifically Rev. Howard Shane (his pastor) and dear friend Pastor Sattgast.

In 1989, he entered Concordia Seminary in St. Louis, Missouri, and graduated in the Spring of 1994 with a Master of Divinity Degree. He continues to grow in the grace of God and further studies. He served in Lord's vineyard at Redeemer, Armour, S.D. for 21 years and Trinity, Hartford, S.D. for 9.5 years. He retired from full-time ministry on Reformation Day 2024.

He has been privileged to serve the South Dakota District on many levels as Circuit Counselor (now Visitor), 2nd Vice President and 1st Vice President. He has served The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod at large as the Vice President for the Great Plains Region, holding the offices of 5th, 3rd and 4th Vice President.
