<sup>1</sup>CSP recommends students do not select COMM 1041 as Small Group Communication does not count toward the Communications General Education Area at CSP. Students who take COMM 1041 may be required to take an additional communication course at CSP. This will increase the minimum total credits to complete at CSP.

<sup>2</sup>CSP recommends students select MATH 1081 as one of their math courses at Century as it will count towards the MAT 135 requirement for the BS Biochemistry. Students who do not take MATH 1081 at Century will be required to take MAT 135 at CSP.

<sup>3</sup>BIO 120 will also fulfill the Natural Science general education area at CSP.

'If the full goal area is not complete, verify with CSP that the chosen course in each goal area will satisfy the indicated general education area. CSP cannot guarantee course transfer if the full goal area is not complete. Students who are not goal area complete and select courses not approved as a general education course at CSP may have additional credit requirements to complete at CSP.

#### **Transfer Policies:**

- The above transfer guide is intended for fully completed MnTC Goal Areas only. Partially completed goal areas will be subject to course-by-course evaluation and does not guarantee transfer to a specific CSP general education area.
- An overall GPA of 2.0 or higher and major GPA of 2.0 or higher is required. (Unless the course applies toward the major, all transfer credit is accepted with a grade of Pass 'P' and does not impact your CSP GPA.).
- A minimum of 120 credits is required to earn a bachelor's degree from CSP. A minimum of 30 credits must be successfully completed at CSP and a maximum of 90 credits will be accepted in transfer.
- A minimum of half of the major credit requirements must be successfully completed at CSP.
- Completion of the full MN Transfer Curriculum will fulfill all general education credits at CSP, with the exception of Theology.
- Students may have additional credits earned from attendance at other schools, please be sure to submit all transcripts.
- The courses listed above are current as of the corresponding Academic Calendar. Course requirements are subject to change.
