- <sup>1</sup>CSP recommends that students select COMM 1101, COMM 1111, or COMM 1131 as Small Group Communication is deemed a major course at CSP. Students who select COMM 1121 will have additional requirements to complete at CSP.
- <sup>2</sup>CSP recommends that students select ECON 2202 as Microeconomics is deemed a major course at CSP. Students who select ECON 2201 will have additional requirements to complete at CSP.
- <sup>3</sup>CSP recommends that students select ACCT 2251 as it will transfer in for BUS 320 at CSP. Students who select ACCT 1053 will still need to complete BUS 320 at CSP.
- <sup>4</sup>Students may receive additional general education credit depending on which MnTC elective courses are completed.
- <sup>5</sup>Students may receive additional major credit depending on which Business electives are completed at Normandale.

Transfer Policies:

- The above transfer guide is intended for fully completed MnTC Goal Areas only. Partially completed goal areas will be subject to course-by-course evaluation and does not guarantee transfer to a specific CSP general education area.
- An overall GPA of 2.0 or higher and major GPA of 2.0 or higher is required. (Unless the course applies toward the major, all transfer credit is accepted with a grade of Pass 'P' and does not impact your CSP GPA.).
- A minimum of 120 credits is required to earn a bachelor's degree from CSP. A minimum of 30 credits must be successfully completed at CSP and a maximum of 90 credits will be accepted in transfer.
- A minimum of half of the major credit requirements must be successfully completed at CSP.
- Completion of the full MN Transfer Curriculum will fulfill all general education credits at CSP, with the exception of Theology.
- Students may have additional credits earned from attendance at other schools, please be sure to submit all transcripts.
- The courses listed above are current as of the corresponding Academic Calendar. Course requirements are subject to change.
