(a) The total cost of the program

For students attending starting in Summer 2024:

- Total tuition and fees paid to CSP: \$69,779
- Total paid to outside vendors for program requirements (e.g., clinical compliance resources, immunizations if paid out of pocket, insurance, NCLEX-RN preparation materials, uniforms, books, post-graduation RN testing and licensure fees, etc.): approximately \$3,961

- Regarding transfer of credit out of CSP: Transfer of credit is always at the discretion of the receiving school and generally depends on the comparability of curricula. No articulation agreements are in place.

(d) **Program length, and the average time students take to graduate by program, and at whole school level**

- Program length once accepted to the nursing program: 4 semesters (16 months)
- Program length including general education, prerequisites, and nursing program: Typically, 4 years

(e) Graduation rate

The ABSN program has a 76.3% completion rate for 2024-2025 at 16 months. Some students take longer to complete the program.

(f) Median borrowing (federal and private loans) amount, and median annual loan payments of students

Looking at the graduating classes in 2024-25, 85% of BSN graduates in Portland took out some form of loan. For those students, the average loan debt was \$62,23.

(g) Loan default rate

The latest 3-year default rate (2022) for CSP is 0% (institution default rate, not BSN), as it is for all schools because loans were not being collected during Covid.

(h) Job placement success which is defined as a percent of students who are employed in the field of study (by program)

During the 2023-24 academic year, 239 Portland ABSN students completed their program. Of the 239 graduates, 104 completed the University's First Destination Survey. Of these 104, 100 (96%) were working or pursuing additional schooling. The remaining 4 alumni were still looking for work at the time of the survey.

(Note: CSP's First Destination Survey is updated annually each October which is why 2023-24 data is the last available and included here).

(i) Median salary for graduates

The University gathers this information as part of its First Destination Survey. For Oregon ABSN students, the average salary reported by graduates during the 2023-24 academic year is **\$89,000**. The University's St. Paul-based BSN graduates have different median salaries, which are not included here, but can be provided upon request by Oregon Higher Education Coordinating Commission.

(j) Gainful employment results as outlined under U.S. Department of Education accountability metrics

CSP does not track Gainful Employment for the BSN as it is not required by the U.S. Department of Education at this time.
