



CONCORDIA UNIVERSITY MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP

The Concordia University, St. Paul Music Scholarship is awarded over two semesters of the school year and will be renewed for three additional years as long as the recipient meets the below criteria:

1. The student must be enrolled full time and maintain satisfactory academic progress during each semester of attendance at Concordia. Additional information about satisfactory academic progress can be found in the 2016-2017 academic catalog.
2. The student must be enrolled in private or group lessons and participate in music ensembles in both the fall and spring semesters. Ensemble options are as follows:
 - 4 hours/week rehearsal: Christus Chorus (MUS714) or Jubilate choir (MUS713)
 - 2 hours/week rehearsal: Concert Band (MUS720), Blue Rondo Jazz Band (MUS750), Opera Workshop (MUS716), Handbell Ensemble (MUS740), or Vox 9 Vocal Jazz Ensemble (MUS717)
 - 1 hour/week rehearsal: Chapel Band (MUS782), Shades of Harmony Gospel Choir (MUS712), Chamber (string) Ensemble (MUS730), Percussion Ensemble (MUS760), CSP Ringers-beginning handbells (CSP739), or Pep Band (fall only-non-registered ensemble)

Note: Students may register for 0, 1, or 2 academic credits as their course load allows.

3. Total scholarships and grants are limited to tuition (and room/board for residential students). Concordia scholarships and grants will be revised if your total scholarships and grants exceed these figures.
